Prop 107 would outlaw gay marriage and ban any domestic partnerships. Families where the partners are not legally married, gay or straight, would lose medical and other benefits if they work for the state, any Arizona city or town, school district, etc.

The exact language of Prop 107 states: "To preserve and protect marriage in this state, only a union between one man and one woman shall be valid or recognized as a marriage by this state or its political subdivisions and no legal status for unmarried persons shall be created or recognized by this state or its political subdivisions that is similar to that of marriage."

The constitutional ban on domestic partnerships goes too far and creates unnecessary harm, particularly for children and families. It is a mean-spirited effort that perpetuates harmful stereotypes about gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender people. **Vote NO on Prop 107!**

### About the Arizona Human Rights Fund, the Endorsement Criteria and Choice

AHRF is the only organization in Arizona that advocates exclusively for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) issues at both the Legislature and the voting booth. As a membership organization, AHRF is supported by the generous contributions of its members.

AHRF volunteer leaders consider these factors when endorsing candidates: candidate questionnaire responses, past voting records, personal and/or professional leadership on LGBT issues, documented public statements, political landscape in the district and candidate interviews (if necessary). AHRF does not endorse based on a candidate's position on choice but does disclose this information. In the 2006 General Election, all AHRF-endorsed candidates are pro-choice, with the following notations:

- (1) Kelleher responded that she supports abortion restrictions such as "third trimester abortions only to save life of mother."
- (2) Monroe did not respond to the Reproductive Freedom question on the AHRF candidate questionnaire.
- (3) Desimone responded that he supports abortion restrictions such as "24-48 hour waiting period that can be circumvented in emergency cases. In general, I think it [abortion] needs to remain legal, safe and available."
- (4) Miranda has a mixed voting record on abortion.
