Arizona Congressional Majority Fund

Any contributions to the Arizona Congressional Majority Fund ("JFC") shall be allocated among the Committees pursuant to FECA and the following method:

- a. Each Candidate Committee shall receive one third (33.33%) of any contribution to the JFC made by an individual or a non-multicandidate federal political committee and designated up to a maximum of \$2,500 for the general election ;
- b. Each Candidate Committee shall receive one third (33.33%) of any contribution to the JFC made by a federal multi-candidate political committee and designated up to a maximum of \$5,000 for the general election;
- c. The National Republican Congressional Committee shall receive any contribution made to the JFC by an individual or non-multicandidate federal political committee, after the first \$7,500, up to a maximum of \$30,800; and
- d. The National Republican Congressional Committee shall any contribution made to the JFC by a federal multi-candidate political committee, after the first \$15,000, up to a maximum of \$15,000; and
- e. The National Republican Congressional Committee Recount Fund shall receive the remainder of any contribution made to the JFC by an individual or non-multicandidate federal political committee, after the first \$38,300, up to a maximum of \$30,800; and
- f. The National Republican Congressional Committee shall receive the remainder of any contribution made to the JFC by a federal multi-candidate political committee, after the first \$30,000, up to a maximum of \$15,000; and

All contributions otherwise permissible under FECA, but which would cause a contributor to exceed any applicable Federal contribution limit to a specific committee, shall be reallocated to the remaining Committees to the extent permitted by FECA according to this allocation formula. Any contributor may designate his or her contribution to a specific participating Committee(s), to the extent permissible by FECA. Any contributor may make his or her contribution payable directly to any of the specific participating Committee(s).

Contributions to the JFC, or any of the participating committees individually, are not deductible as charitable contributions for Federal income tax purposes. All funds received in response to this solicitation will be subject to federal contribution limits and prohibitions. Contributions from corporations, labor union, foreign nationals without "green cards," and federal government contractors are prohibited.

The maximum amount an individual or a non-multicandidate political committee may contribute to JFC is \$69,100. **Contributions to the NRCC Recount Fund DO NOT count against either the NRCC contribution limit for 2012 or the individual aggregate biennial contribution limit.** The maximum amount a multi-candidate political committee may contribute to JFC is \$45,000.

Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer of each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in an election cycle or calendar year, as applicable.
